



Statement of Faith

God – There is only one God! Creator of everything. Completely perfect. Omniscient, Omnipotent, and Omnipresent. Eternally existing in three manifestations: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; all being co-equal. Phil. 2:6

The Father – Greater than all, Source of the Word (Logos) and the Begetter. Jn. 14:28; 16:28; 1:14.

Jesus Christ – The Son is the Word made flesh, Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten, and has existed with the Father from the Beginning and created everything. He is wholly God and wholly man, supernaturally conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary. John. 1-14

* He is a loving Savior who:

1. Willingly allowed the sacrifice of His life by dying on the cross for our sins!
2. Rose from the dead with all power in His hand,
3. Ascended into heaven, where at the right hand of the Father, He intercedes for us as our High Priest and Advocate. Hebrews. 1:2-11
4. His ministry is to bridge the sin gulf that existed between The Father and Fallen man.

The Holy Spirit – He proceeds from both the Father and the Son and He is eternal. John. 14:26

* The Comforter's ministry is to:

1. Glorify the Lord Jesus Christ
2. Indwell, Teach, Empower, Nurture, Guide, and Lead the believer into godly living and service. John. 14:26, Acts 1:8, 19:2
3. Convict men of sin.

The Bible – The Scriptures, are the inspired Word of God, given unto men by the Holy Spirit to reveal:

1. God's Will and Love for Man
2. Man's need for Salvation's liberty provided only by Jesus Christ II Cor. 3:17
3. God's Wisdom concerning doctrine, conduct, correction, and right living. II Tim. 3:16
4. The discovery of who we are meant to be in Jesus Christ.

Salvation – The shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only ground for justification and salvation. Only those who receive Jesus Christ by faith are born of the Holy Spirit and thus become children of God. Romans. 5:9, 1 Corinthians. 6:11

Baptism – Baptism is:

1. Water immersion
2. A direct commandment of our Lord
3. For Believers only
4. A symbol that Christians identify with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection. Matthew. 28:19, Romans. 6:4, Colossians. 2:12, Acts 8:36-39

Communion – The Lord's Supper is a memorial service that sacredly symbolizes the sacrificial death of our Lord Jesus Christ; all Believers should share in it. 1 Corinthians. 11:24-25
